

Please bring canned food (veggies, soup, beans, etc.), cereal boxes, hygiene items (soap, shampoo, toothpaste, etc.), rice, pasta, and peanut butter. A complete list will be provided at the lodge. This year, we are challenging ourselves to a 1K where we donate either 1,000 pounds of food, \$1,000, or any combination of the two.
